

To celebrate the 2025 Drinking Water Week, Hardin County Water District No.1 would like to share some information about our 2 Water Distribution Systems:

The Fort Knox Distribution System

The Ft. Knox Distribution System has 2 water tanks that each can hold 1.5 million gallons of water

Our Ft. Knox Distribution team consists of:

- 1 Distribution Supervisor
- 2 Heavy Equipment Operators
- 5 Distribution Operators
- 1 Administrative Specialist

The Ft. Knox Distribution system has 156.7 miles of water lines to maintain- for reference, Ft. Knox to Nashville is 145 miles away

There are 1,050 hydrants on Ft. Knox that are maintained by our crews



The Hardin County Water District No.1 Distribution System

The HCWD1 Distribution System has 4 water tanks that can hold a total of 2.47 million gallons of water

Our Distribution team consists of:

- 1 Distribution Supervisor
- 2 Heavy Equipment Operators
- 3 Field Service Representatives
- 6 Distribution Operators

The HCWD1 Distribution System has 307.3 miles of water mains to maintain- for reference, Radcliff to Chicago is 339 miles away

There are 1,081 hydrants in the HCWD1 System that are maintained by our crews
